Guidelines for submissions

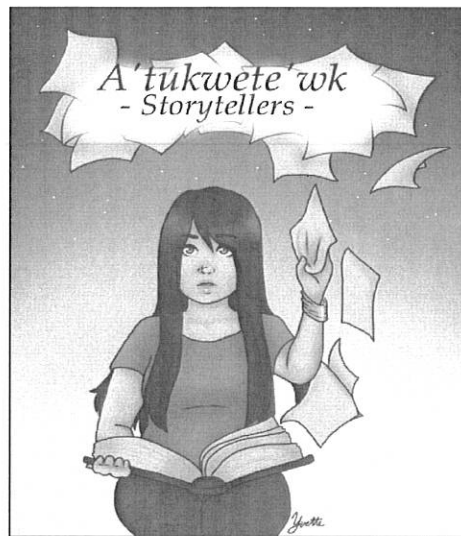
Mi'kmaw Kina'matnewey is planning to publish its second book of student writing and art. We are looking for submissions from students in Grades 6 -12. Multiple genres and writing formats will be included in this year's anthology. Please send along narrative, information and/or persuasive text, biographical or auto-biographical pieces, journal entries, poetry, ballads, plays, comic strips, political cartoons, songs, art work, collages, original photography (with a write-up) and so on.



The Process:

- Students are invited to submit three pieces of writing and/or art to Director of Education, Janice Francis, at janicefrancis@acadiaband.ca
- Students' should choose their best work. Written work should be *edited* i.e. spelling, grammar, and punctuation should be correct.
- Writing should be *typed* and sent via an e-mail attachment.
- Each piece of work (writing and/or art) should have the student's full name, school, grade, and First Nation community.
- The deadline for submissions is **Thursday, April 13, 2017**. No extensions will be given.
- An event will be held on *June 9, 2017*, at Allison Bernard Memorial High School in Eskasoni to celebrate our Mi'kmaw student artists and authors and to present them with the anthology containing their published work.
- Students whose work is published, as well as their teachers, their schools, and their school boards/and offices will receive a free copy of the anthology.
