## The Process:

- Students are invited to submit three pieces of writing and/or art to Director of Education,
   Janice Francis, at janicefrancis@acadiaband.ca
- Students' should choose their best work. Written work should be *edited* i.e. spelling, grammar, and punctuation should be correct.
- Writing should be typed and sent via an e-mail attachment.
- Each piece of work (writing and/or art) should have the student's full name, school, grade, and First Nation community.
- The deadline for submissions is Thursday, April 13, 2017. No extensions will be given.
- An event will be held on June 9, 2017, at Allison Bernard Memorial High School in Eskasoni
  to celebrate our Mi'kmaw student artists and authors and to present them with the
  anthology containing their published work.
- Students whose work is published, as well as their teachers, their schools, and their school boards/band offices will receive a free copy of the anthology.
