Job Opportunity Term Position Language Lead

POSITION SCOPE: The Language Lead will work closely with the Language Developer who will coordinate the project as well as assist with the development of all language resources. They will assist in creating a unified approach for the progression of language acquisition, although communities will intersect that progression at various stages depending on existing language skills. The Language Developer will explore the role of social and digital media, including archiving and other digital access for the project. With the Language Lead, the Language Developer will create the 24 activity/task cards for each community (equaling 162 activity cards), and monitor and feedback on each weekly activity for each session. They will integrate language experts at Mi'kmaw Kinamatnewey as well as the Resolution Health Support Worker as necessary.

Acadia First Nation is seeking to contract a language lead for this project for Acadia First Nation. We have identified in our budget a contracted rate of \$25/hour for 240 hours (or 12 weeks) that would be spread over nine months.

We are looking for someone that can assist with the following:

Language Lead:

One Language Lead will be contracted and will be the anchor for the program, serving as a central resource for each weekly session. They will facilitate the language gatherings in their communities as well as play an important role in the development of their community's activity/task cards. With the Language Developer, the Language Lead will monitor and feedback on each weekly activity for each session.
