(for Tusket Dam restoration project with Nova Scotia Power)

Acadia First Nation is looking to hire a Mi'kmaq Observer for the Tusket dam restoration project with Nova Scotia Power (NSPI). At present, NSPI is getting ready to begin work on the Tusket dam to rebuild the existing dam structure and bridge to meet current standards and codes.

Due to the cultural significant and archaeological potential of this project, Acadia First Nation is looking to hire an observer to take part in this project. The observer will work in collaboration with the construction company, NSPI, KMKNO and the archaeologists that are on site. They will be required to be on site during specific times of the project to monitor and observe work being done and to ensure that appropriate protocols are followed in the event that items of archaeological significance are suspected and/or discovered. Observer will be required to report to Acadia First Nation on a weekly basis.

This is a part-time position and will expand over the duration of the project. The project is expected to be completed by November 2018. The work is expected to take place from August to December, 2017 and June to November 2018.

The hours each week may vary from 16-40 hours per week depending on the scope of work being done at any particular time.
