Acadia First Nation has been selected and funded through Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada to create an Emergency Management Plan inclusive to all AFN aboriginal communities.

The success of such a plan relies on the dedicated involvement of Mi'kmaq people from every AFN community over a two year period.

The goal of the program is to have resilient communities able to support each other and secure band-owned businesses during weather or other emergency events while connecting with municipal, provincial and federal emergency responders and networks.

During the next 2 years of the development phase of this program, we are looking for at least 2 volunteers from each community to help staff develop plans and procedures that are realistic for your specific community needs, resources and people.

Training and travel costs for persons interested in being involved will be covered. There may be additional opportunities that may present themselves if this initiative is deemed a success over the coming two years.
