Notification Program Overview

The Confederacy of Mainland Mi'kmaq has launched a new Mass Notification service that allows each of our 8 member communities to alert their residents in the event of an emergency or hazard. You opt-in to enter your contact information and subscribe to notifications you care about. The information you provide is protected and will not be used for any other purpose.

By signing up for the Mainland Mi'kmaq Emergency Alert System you are consenting to receive Emergency Notifications from your Community. You may cancel your sign up at any time by deleting your profile on the Everbridge Web Portal, the Everbridge App or by contacting your Community Operator.

How It Works:

When your community issues a notification about a potential safety hazard or emergency event, you will receive a message on the voice or text communication methods that you have registered. If requested for the notification, you can confirm that you have received the message and you will not be contacted by any subsequent methods regarding that notification. If you do not confirm, the system will continue to attempt to reach you through all the contact paths that you have registered.

Sign up for Notifications:

Create an account and add your contact and location information into the Mass Notification system. This can be done through the Everbridge web portal or through the Everbridge App. All information you provide will be kept strictly confidential.

Stop Receiving Notifications:

You can stop receiving at any time by removing your contact information from your profile.

Emergency Alert Program: Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Emergency Alert Program?

This service allows you to opt-in to receive notifications via phone calls, text messaging, e-mail and more based on locations you care about. You can choose to receive notifications about events that may affect your community and will help keep you and your family safe.

When will it be used?

This system will be used to notify you about imminent threats to health and safety as well as informational notifications that affect your community. Community based operators will send notifications regarding severe weather, flooding, evacuations and more.

Will I still get emergency notifications if I do not sign up?

If you do not create a username and password, and go through the sign-up process, you will not receive notifications from Everbridge.

What if my phone number or email address changes?

If your contact information changes, you can always visit your profile and update your information. Your profile is accessible from the online portal and through the mobile Everbridge App. If you have trouble updating your contact information, you can contact your community operator for assistance.

Will my contact information be shared with others?

No. The information that you provide will be used only for the purpose of emergency notifications. Access to the information stored in Everbridge is limited and your information will not be shared.
