

Ponhook Trust Report 2013/2014

The Balance of the Ponhook trust was \$500,584.00 as of Oct. 17, 2014.

This past year two projects were approved.

\$150,000.00 was approved for the Wildcat Community Hall. The hall is nearly completed. To date \$100,000 has been withdrawn from the trust for this project. The final \$50,000 will be withdrawn shortly to pay the final bills as they come in.

Also approved was a basket making workshop. This workshop was held in the Wildcat Community this past spring. The total amount from the trust was \$5454.90.

Previously approved from the trust was \$200,000.00 for the purchase of land in Shelburne. To date land has not been purchased and this amount remains in the trust.

The amount available for future projects is approximately \$250,584.00.
